1. Vote on Tuesday, March 3!

If you haven't already voted, Tuesday is THE DAY to cast your ballot in the 2020 Primary. Your ballot will have races ranging from President to local judges, and all of us will be voting to choose who will be on the ballot to represent you in the Texas House of Representatives. Don't miss this important civic duty! And as a reminder: Texas has an open Primary, so you don't need to be registered to any party in order to vote.
