Hi y'all,

Keeping this week's actions brief and focused on the primary runoff elections!

1. VOTE

If you're receiving this newsletter, I assume you are a regular voter and don't need any encouragement or convincing to get out and vote. Reminders about dates can be helpful. If you voted in a party primary in March, you can vote in that same party's runoff. More than ever, please consider voting early to try to avoid large gatherings at the polls on Election Day.

TX Lege races in the runoff include:

- *Democratic Railroad Commissioner Candidates*
- *State Board of Education Candidates (varies by region)*
- *Texas Senate District 19 (may be flippable in the general)*
- *Texas Senate District 27 - where anti-abortion Democrat Eddie Lucio Jr will face challenger Sara Stapleton Barrera*

NOTE: this election includes a [Special Election to fill Senate District 14](#)

Important dates: Early voting - Monday, June 29 - Friday, July 10

Last day to apply to vote by mail -

Thursday, July 2

Election Day - Tuesday, July 14

2. Encourage a friend or three to vote too

It's hard to remember when runoffs are scheduled, especially when there is so much happening in our state. Give a few friends a reminder about the upcoming election, and a nudge to get out and vote.

3. Wear a mask, practice good hygiene, and social distance when you're out at the polls

If you plan on voting in person, don't forget to mask-up, wash your hands for 20+ seconds before and after voting, bring hand sanitizer with you, avoid touching your face, and maintain a minimum of 6 ft between you and others.
