Hope you were able to breathe a sigh of relief with the inauguration this last week. Time to channel that positive energy into improving our state!

### 1. Attend a Redistricting Hearing

**Attend an upcoming redistricting hearing.** Back before the pandemic, a full slate of redistricting hearings were scheduled across the state. The vast majority were cancelled, of course. However, just a few days ago the Senate Redistricting Committee released new dates, and they start **Monday, January 25**. Check their [proposed schedule of hearings](#) to find a hearing you're able to attend. To provide spoken testimony, you must register 24 hours in advance of the hearing. All spoken testimony will be done via two-way video conference, and your audio and video must work to participate.
