1. Testify for Fair Maps

Testify about redistricting maps on Monday, October 4 at 9 am, either in person or in writing

Redistricting is hugely important, and it can seem daunting. My challenge to you: take a look at the new maps. Is your neighborhood split up? Are you lumped in with areas that have absolutely nothing in common with your area? Those are the types of issues you can highlight in your testimony. 2. Call to Save Lives

Call Members of the House Constitutional Rights and Remedies Select Committee to OPPOSE anti-trans bill HB 25. Call Public Ed Chair Harold Dutton to OPPOSE SB 3 and HB 10

We asked you to call about SB 3 and HB 10 last week, and now we're adding HB 25 to the list too. We have got to stop the Texas GOP as they continue to go after trans kids. [Find out more about HB 25, who you can call, and what you can say on our website.](#)

3. Call to Protect Public Health

Call your State Senator and State Rep to oppose any bills that bar employers from requiring COVID-19 vaccinations

4. Learn and Make a Plan to Vote

Learn about the 8 Texas Constitutional Amendments that are on the ballot in November, then make your plan to vote!

The last day to register to vote in the November election is Monday, Oct 4. Then early voting starts October 18!
